The primary role of a Lift Fitter is to ensure the safe operation and maintenance of all of Perisher's lifting systems including Chairlifts, T-Bars, J-Bars, Rope Tows and Skier Conveyors.

Your responsibilities as a Lift Fitter include but are not limited to:

- Scheduled and non-scheduled maintenance and repairs of ski lifts
- Ensuring that all lift facilities and associated areas are safe to operate
- Daily set up, start up and shut down of lifts
- Day to day operations of the lifting system
- Regular maintenance and operational checks
- Informing and reporting to Managers and Supervisors of lift conditions
- Informing Managers, Supervisors and Mountain Office personnel of the operational status of lifts
- Communicating daily with Lift staff, Area Managers and Supervisors, non-mountain staff and guests.

As a Lift Fitter's position is primarily an outdoors role, applicants need to aware that all kinds of weather will be encountered and an above average level of fitness will be required. Working at heights is also a requirement in this role.

Lift Fitters are employed under the Perisher Trades Enterprise Agreement where remuneration is commensurate with experience and qualifications. The base rate of pay will range from \$31.25 to \$38.00 per hour depending on your experience and qualifications and there are significant overtime opportunities during the season.

To be considered for this role you **must** have a current driver's licence and Certificate III in a mechanical discipline. Electricians may be considered to fill this role, depending on experience.
